INFORMATION FOR VOTERS

On Thursday 11 September 2014 there will be a Referendum on the Chaddesley Corbett Neighbourhood Plan. This leaflet explains more about the Referendum and how you can take part.

Neighbourhood planning aims to help local communities play a direct role in planning for the areas in which they live and work.

The Referendum will ask you to vote 'YES' or 'NO' to a question. The question on the ballot paper will be:

Do you want Wyre Forest District Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Chaddesley Corbett to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?

If more people vote YES than NO in the Referendum then Wyre Forest District Council will use the Neighbourhood Plan to help it decide planning applications in Chaddesley Corbett.

Ways to Vote

If you are on the Electoral Register you should have received a Poll Card. If you are not on the Electoral Register you have until Tuesday 26 August to register and take part in the Referendum. You can vote:

In Person—at the Village Hall between 7.00 a.m. to 10.00 p.m. If you would like a lift to the village hall please contact the Parish Clerk on 01299 851654.

By Post—Anyone registered for a postal vote will get this about a week before the Referendum. If you would like to vote by post, complete and return an application form to the District Council by 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 27 August 2014.

By Proxy—If you can't get to the Village Hall and don't want to vote by post, you may be able to vote by proxy—this means you can ask someone you trust to vote on your behalf. Applications should be sent to the District Council by 5.00 p.m. on Wednesday 3 September.
